VIII.	Discussion – Update on Electric Bills and Net Metering Agreement with OP Solar Project (see attached email)					
	Chris discussed discrepancies with the VEC and Green Lantern (OP Solar) bills and their recording of net metering credits. Chris will contact					

VEC to learn more. At this point, the CCF electric bill is no longer part of the net metering program. This was discontinued in fall 2020. Our electric bills at this point should be for electricity use only and not for purchasing solar credits.

IX. Discussion – Trail Map Review and Grants Received by the Canaan Naturally Connected Group.

Diana and Gana discussed grants received by the Canaan Naturally Connected group that pertain to the Community Forest. There is presently \$5000 available to fix road at north end, build a kiosk for the trailhead, and put in a parking spot. Chris will work with the CNC to get these improvements made.

There are also funds for another community forum to survey interest in the CCF. The CNC group will work on getting this done.

X. Discussion – Update on Use of Property by DAgNR Students and Approval to Stock Pond with Trout

Chris requested using "syrup funds" to purchase a few trout to stock the pond as a "test" to see if they will survive. These fish will also be used for educational purposes by his class and the summer school program.
